ReadUP:

- Volunteer reading tutors are needed in all 4 ReadUP schools in Morgan County. The goal is to have 90 volunteer tutors for the 2016-17 school year.
 1. Newby Memorial Elementary, Mooresville Cons. School Corp., Program Time: 8:00-9:00am, Tuesday-Thursday, (Volunteers select one day for one hour to serve, either Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday from 8-9am.)
 2. Paragon Elementary, MSD Martinsville, Program Time: 8:35-9:35 am, Tuesday-Thursday, (Volunteers select one day for one hour to serve, either Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday from 8:35-9:35 am.)
 3. Poston Road Elementary, MSD Martinsville, Program Time: 2:00-3:00 pm, Tuesday-Thursday, (Volunteers select one day for one hour to serve, either Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday from 2-3 pm.)
 4. Monrovia Elementary, Monroe-Gregg School Corp., Program Time: 7:30-8:30am Tuesday-Thursday, (Volunteers select one day for one hour to serve, either Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday from 7:30-8:30am.)

- The week of August 1-5: approximately 50 volunteers are needed to help the week prior to distribution day on August 6 to sort supplies and set up for the big event day.
- On Backpack Attack distribution day, (Saturday, August 6), 50-75 volunteers are needed from 7:30am-12 noon to help check in students and “shop” with the children. Volunteers take the students through the community room and help them shop for their school supplies and select a backpack.



Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA)

- VITA is the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program that offers free tax service preparation for those taxpayers qualifying with a household income of \$60,000 and below in 2016. This is also known as Indy Free Tax Prep. This program is in partnership and funded by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS).
- Volunteers should be customer service oriented and enjoy preparing taxes. Training is provided. Approximately 12-20 hours of training will be required to become a certified volunteer tax preparer through the IRS.
- VITA volunteers are needed throughout the tax season in 2017. Volunteers may choose which days and times they would like to serve at one of the following VITA locations:
 - Mooresville Public Library, 220 W Harrison, Mooresville, Indiana 46158
 - Morgan County Public Library, 20 S Jefferson Street, Martinsville, IN 46151
