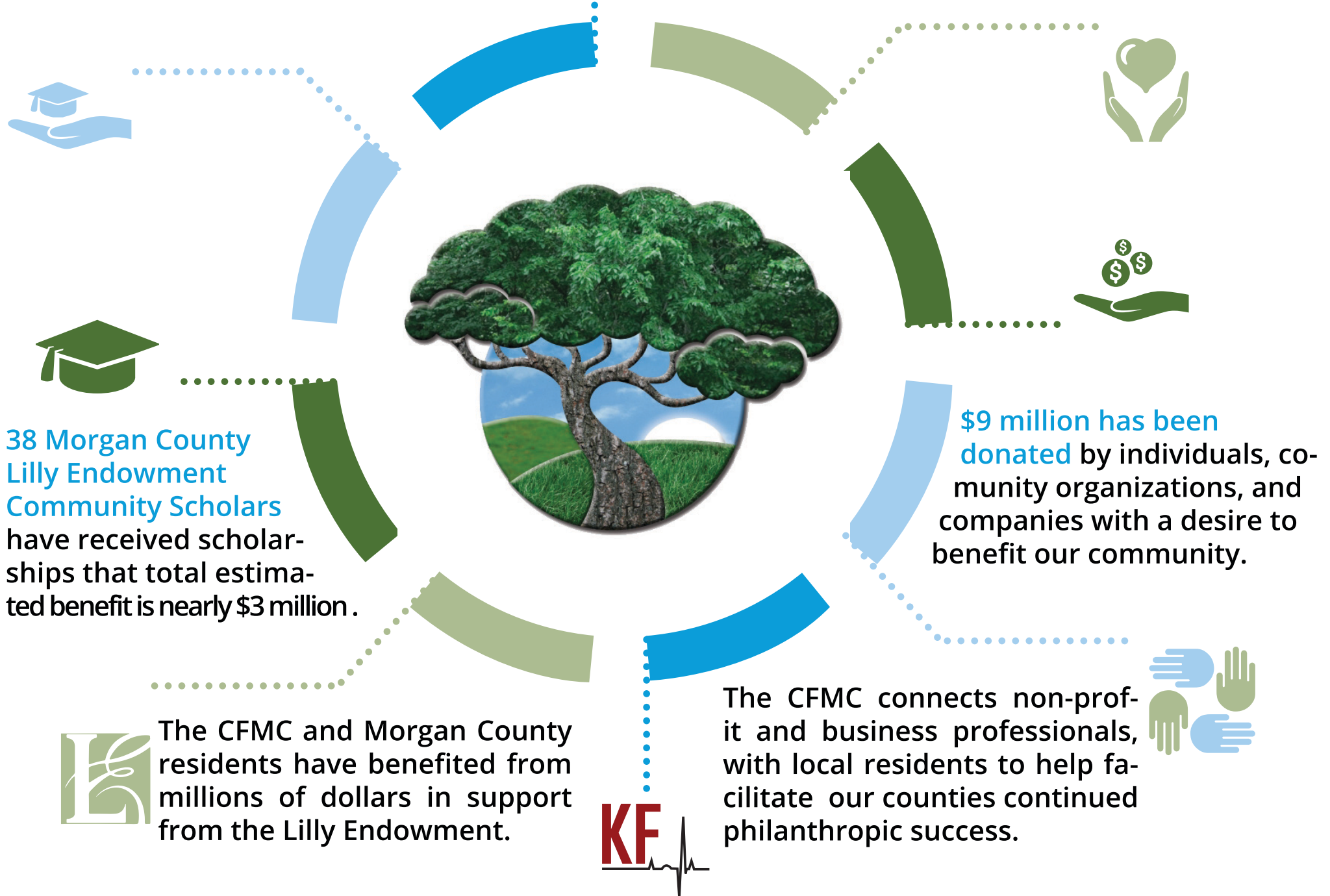
## 15 Years of Service.

### COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF MORGAN COUNTY

200+ funds have supported local community programs, projects and scholarships through donations and support at the CFMC.

550+ scholarships have been awarded to students of all ages, totaling nearly \$800,000.

300+ grants have been awarded to programs and projects benefiting Morgan County, totaling nearly \$600,000.



Since 2003, the CFMC has partnered with the Kendrick Foundation to help provide 382 health-related grants totaling more than \$12 million and 430 scholarships totaling more than \$5 million.

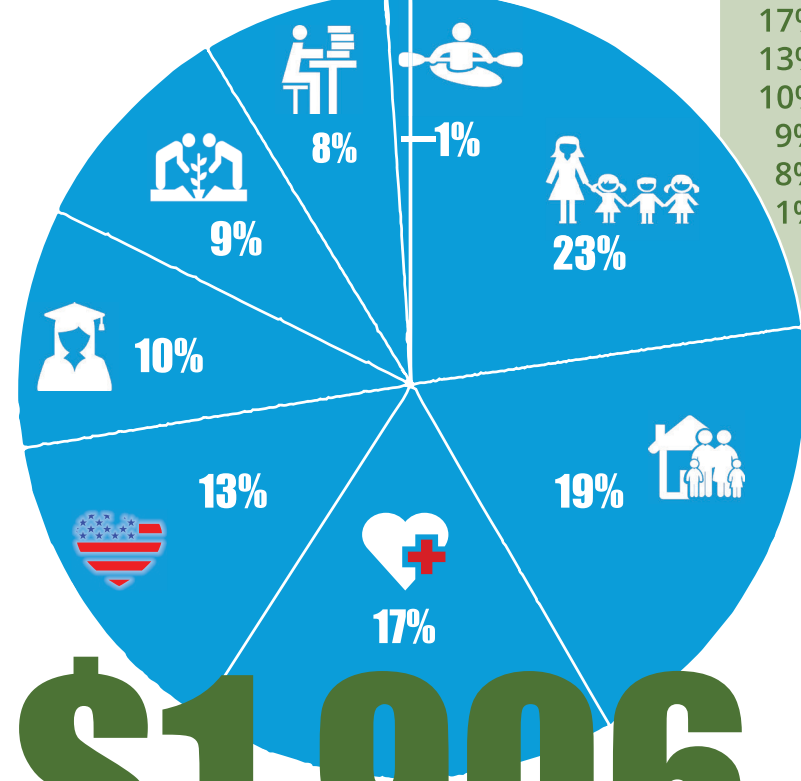
